

## **JUNE 10, 2019 MONTHLY MEETING**

### **TOWN OF HARRISON**

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, June 10, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Dean Lashua called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Dan & Deborah Dowell, Lee & Sue Halverson, John Phillips, Diane Troast, Diane Erickson, Patricia Johnson, Bob Opperman, Bob Kasson, Casey Beyersdorf, Ann Casamassa, Jon Ann Kasson, and Fran Moen.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Casamassa to accept the minutes as read, Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance in the checkbook on May 1, 2019 was \$97,919.18. Deposits for the month totaled \$957.16. The total of checks and withdrawals was \$11,744.09. The balance in the checkbook on May 31, 2019 was \$87,132.25. The Money Market account had a beginning balance of \$21,790.15 and the interest for the month was \$7.40. The ending balance in the account was \$21797.55.

**OLD BUSINESS:** The signs allowing the use of ATV/UTV's in the Township have arrived and will be put up as soon as possible.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Casey Beyersdorf gave the Board and those present all the services that are available from Waupaca County Highway Department to the Townships. The Town Board has asked the County if it was possible for them to take over the snow removal in Harrison after the 2019-2020 winter season. They have requests from 2 other townships requesting the same service. There are many steps that have to be taken by the county before they can consider our request. The Board will be kept informed as the process continues. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Casamassa to grant the renewal of tavern license to Schmidt's Corners LLC and Northland Sports Bar and Grill LLC from July 1, 2019 until June 30, 2020. Motion carried. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Casamassa to grant bartender license to Adam Garvy, Sue McGlin and Cynthia Berry. Motion carried. Supervisors 1 and 2 have attended a workshop for Town Officials that was held In May. John Lashua will

start grading town roads and Scott Construction will begin our summer road repair. Calls and concerns received by the Board during the month were discussed. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Casamassa to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 P.M. Motion carried.
